

# CAIRNBROOK MINER FATALLY INJURED

## Stephen Surkovic Caught Under Fall of Coal at Loyalhanna Operations

Stephen Surkovic, aged 48 years, was fatally injured while at work in the Loyalhanna Coal Company's mines at Cairnbrook, Somerset County, yesterday afternoon, when he was caught under a fall of coal. The body was turned over to Undertaker Pentrack, who prepared it for burial and removed it to the Surkovic home this morning. Funeral services will be held in St. John the Baptist's Catholic Church, Central City, on Monday morning by the Rev. Father Banik, with interment in the church cemetery.

The deceased was born in Europe in 1880, coming to America many years ago and locating in this vicinity. He and Miss Mary E. Vasko were married at Scalp Level in 1906. She survives him with five children, Stephen, jr., of Detroit, and Anna, John, Michael and Mary at home. In addition to these he is survived by a brother and two sisters in Europe and a brother residing at Houtzdale.
