

# CAIRNBROOK MINER FATALLY INJURED

Dies Shortly After Arrival at  
Windber Hospital; Vic-  
tim's Back Broken

WINDBER, April 26.—As a result of injuries received this morning while caught in a coal cutting machine while at work in Reitz No. 2 mine of the Reitz Coal Company, Stanley Jerz, aged 21, unmarried, of Cairnbrook, died 15 minutes after his admission to the Windber Hospital. The victim's back was broken and both legs badly crushed. He was brought to the hospital at 8:40 o'clock.

The deceased is survived by his parents, Anthony and Maary Jerz, of Cairnbrook; one sister, Victoria, and these brothers, Andrew, William, John, Walter, Joseph and Francis, all at home.

Coroner H. S. Kimmell, of Somerset, was notified of the fatality and will conduct an inquest tomorrow. The body was turned over to Undertaker W. J. Baer to prepare for burial. Arrangements for the funeral have not yet been completed.
